COVID-19: Canada Emergency Response Benefit Application

Eligibility

Fields marked with an asterisk (*) are required.

Important: You are not entitled to receive the Canada Emergency Response Benefit (CERB) from the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) while you are receiving Employment Insurance (EI) benefits or the CERB from Service Canada. If you have already submitted an application with Service Canada for EI or the CERB, you cannot apply for this benefit through CRA.

To be eligible, you must meet the following requirements:

- · You reside in Canada.
- You are 15 years of age or older at the time of application.
- For your first CERB application: you have stopped or will stop working due to reasons related to COVID-19 and, for at least 14 consecutive days of the four week period for which you are applying, you will not be receiving:
 - employment income;
 - · self-employment income; or
 - · provincial or federal benefits related to maternity or paternity leave.
- For your subsequent CERB applications: you continue to not be working due to reasons related to COVID-19 and, for the four week period for which
- you are applying, you will not be receiving:
- employment income;
- self-employment income; or
- provincial or federal benefits related to maternity or paternity leave.
- · You have not quit your job voluntarily.
- You have not applied for, nor are you receiving, CERB or EI benefits from Service Canada for the same eligibility period.
- You have earned a minimum of \$5,000 income within the last 12 months or in 2019 from one or more of the following sources:

 - self-employment income; or
 - provincial or federal benefits related to maternity or paternity leave.

Eligibility periods:

- · Eligibility periods are fixed in four week periods.
- · You may apply for CERB for up to a maximum of 16 weeks.

Note: If you are later found to be ineligible, you will be required to repay the benefit.
